

Ontario's System-Wide Electricity Supply Mix*

Ontario's electricity supply comes from a variety of sources. In 2014, Ontario's reliance on nuclear, water, and wind energy increased, while the use of natural gas energy decreased. Coal generation declined to almost zero percent. Ontario's electricity system will continue to evolve throughout 2015 and beyond with the increased use of renewable generation, including solar and wind.
