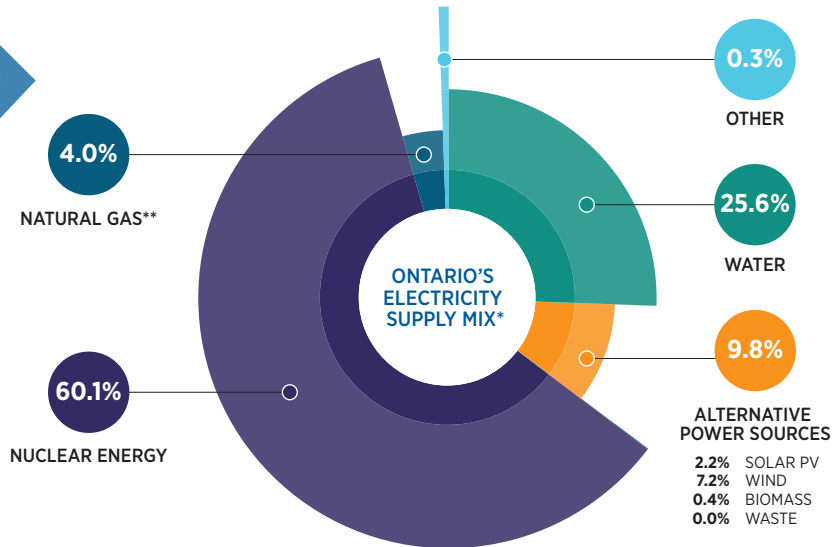


# Ontario's System-Wide Electricity Supply Mix

Ontario's electricity supply comes from various sources. Throughout 2017, Ontario's reliance on nuclear, water power and alternative power sources such as wind increased, while the use of natural gas and biomass declined. Ontario's electricity supply mix is expected to continue to change throughout and beyond 2018 as industry and consumer needs evolve.
