



Winter is over!

Now it's time to adjust your thermostat from Heat to Cool.



Step 1.

Press the “**SYSTEM**” button until the word “**COOL**” is flashing. Then press “**DONE**” (lower left square changes from “**SCHED**” to “**DONE**”. The “**COOL**” will stop flashing.)

Step 2.

Temporarily set the temperature to lower than the current room temperature (example 23°C). “**WAIT**” will show in the lower right just below “**SET TO**” temperature display.

A faint “click” will be heard and the air conditioner will come on. “**WAIT**” will now disappear and “**COOL ON**” will appear.

(Note: on some systems there could be a 10-15 minute delay). Once you hear the compressor fan running, you should feel cool air at the vent.



Additional troubleshooting tips:

- Remember that you need to check that the air conditioner cover has been removed.
- Make sure that the air conditioner power breaker is switched on. Your breaker color could be any color; but most likely black. It should have the number 20, 25 or even 30 on it. Turn it on and give the air conditioner a few minutes to turn on after you have changed your thermostat settings.
