


Summer is over!

Now it's time to adjust your thermostat from Cool to Heat.



Step 1.

Press the **"SYSTEM**" button until the word **"HEAT**" is flashing. Then press **"DONE**" (lower left square changes from **"SCHED**" to **"DONE**". The **"HEAT**" will stop flashing.)



Step 2.

Temporarily set the temperature to higher than the current room temperature (example 24°C). **"WAIT**" will show in the lower right just below **"SET TO**" temperature display.

A faint "click" will be heard and the heat will come on. "**WAIT**" will now disappear and "**HEAT ON**" will appear.

(Note: on some systems there could be a 10-15 minute delay). Once you hear the fan running, you should feel warm air at the vent.

Additional troubleshooting tips:

- Press SYSTEM to set the system to HEAT. Make sure the temperature is set higher than the inside temperature.
- Check circuit breaker and reset if necessary.
- Make sure power switch at heating and cooling system is on.
- Make sure furnace door is closed securely.
